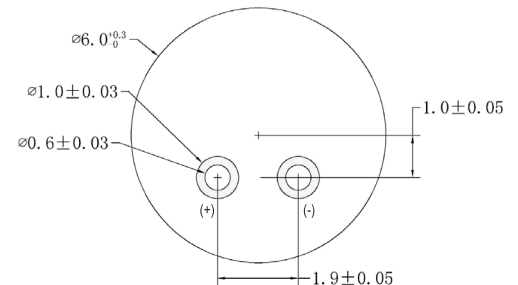

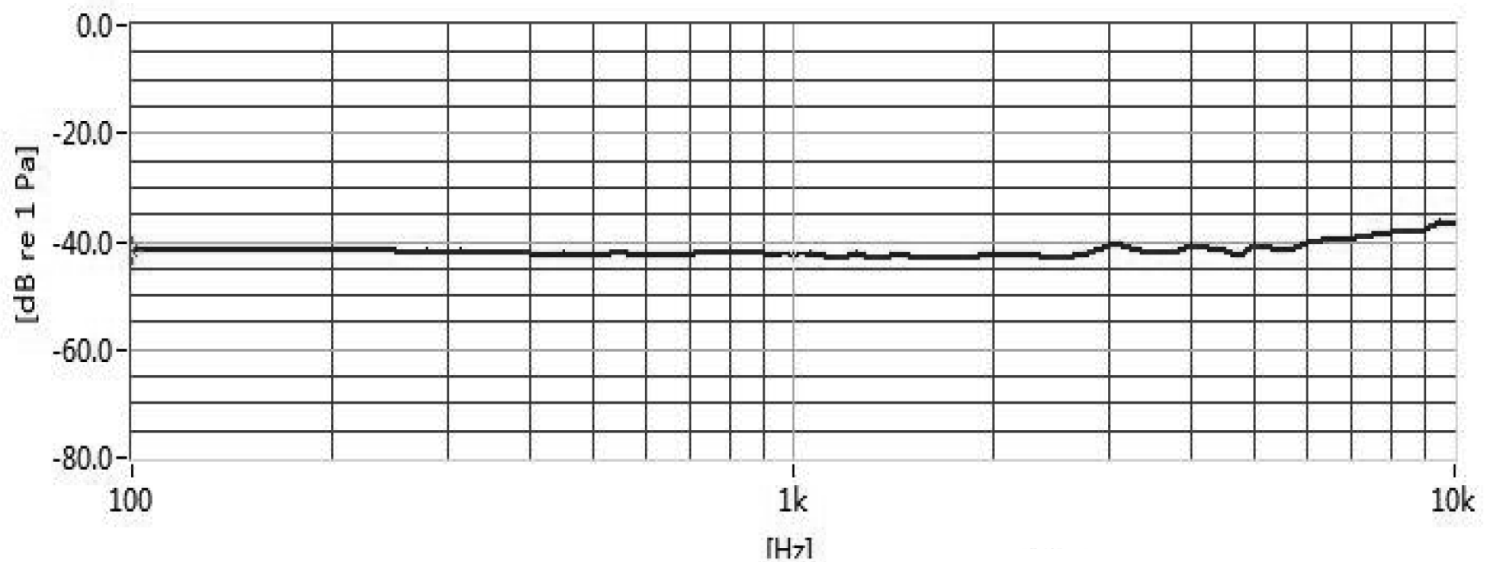

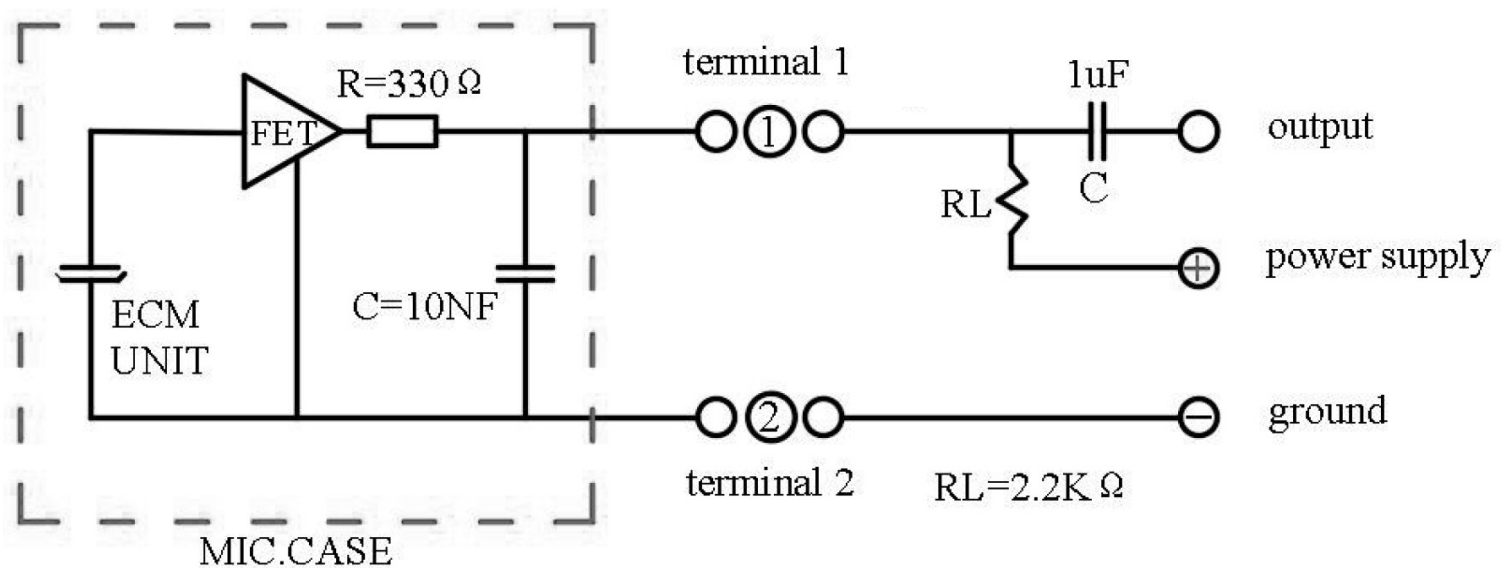


Recommended PCB Layout

FREQUENCY RESPONSE CURVE

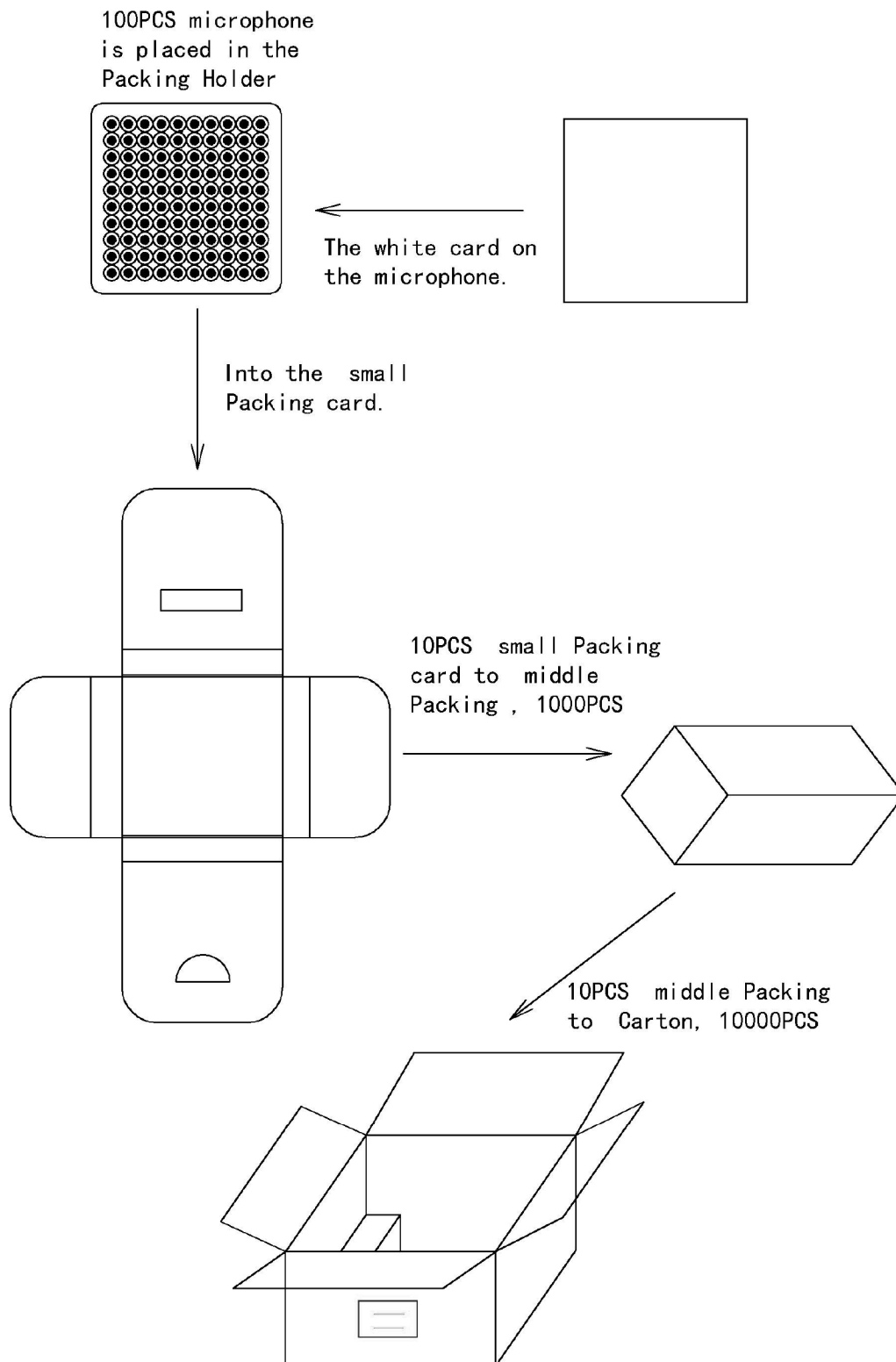


APPLICATION CIRCUIT
