

USB-MODEVM SW-2 Setup for TSC2005 EVM-PDK.

Please double check the SW2-1, SW2-2 and SW2-3 on USB-MODEVM board and make sure that: at least one of the three is OFF, before install the TSC2005 EVM board on top of USB-MODEVM board. Refer to the UG on the install position.

For example, you can set the USB-MODEVM SW2 as:

	SW2-7	ON
	SW2-8	OFF

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
