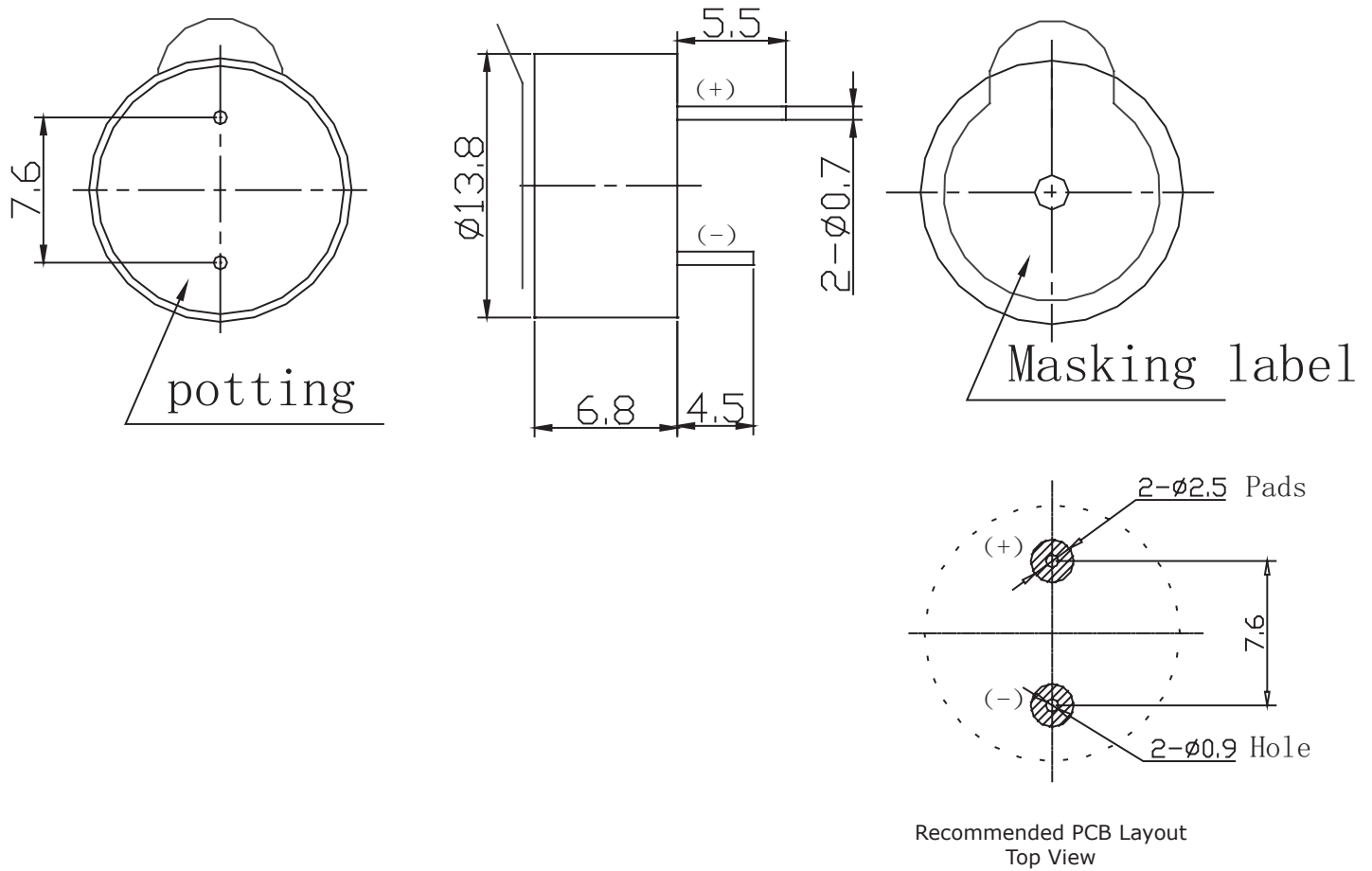

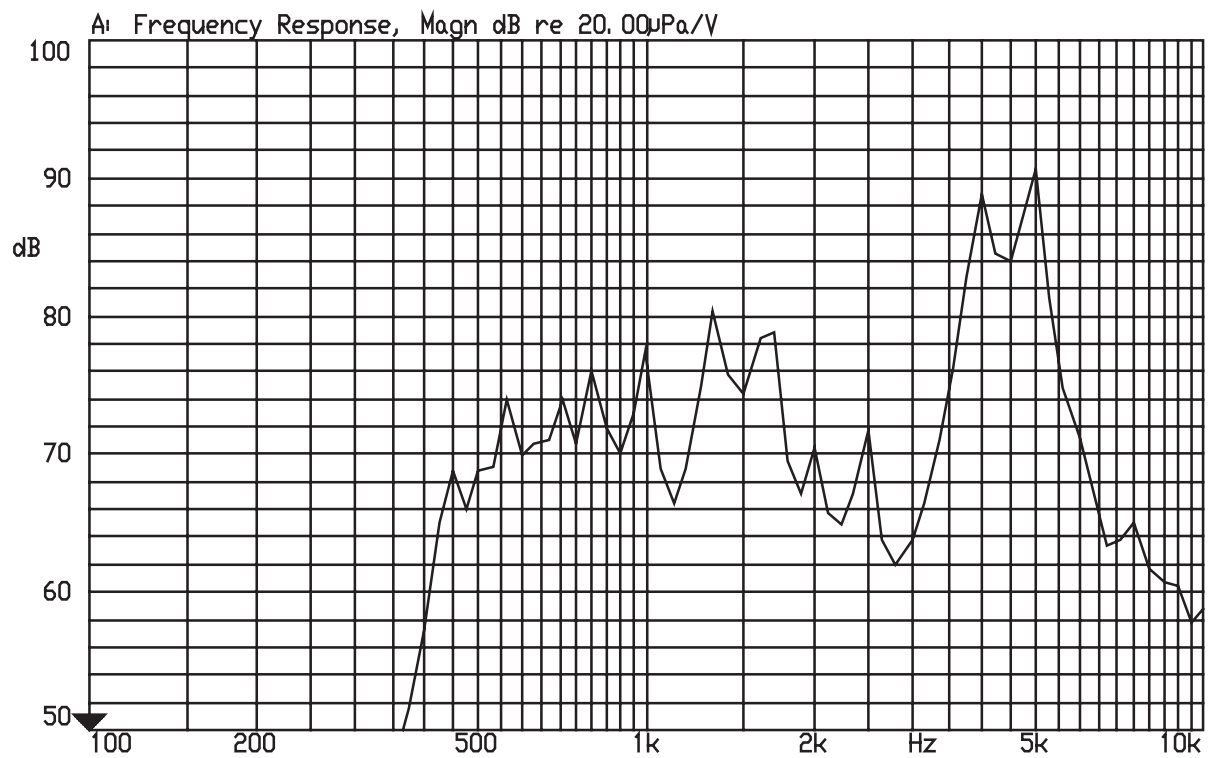

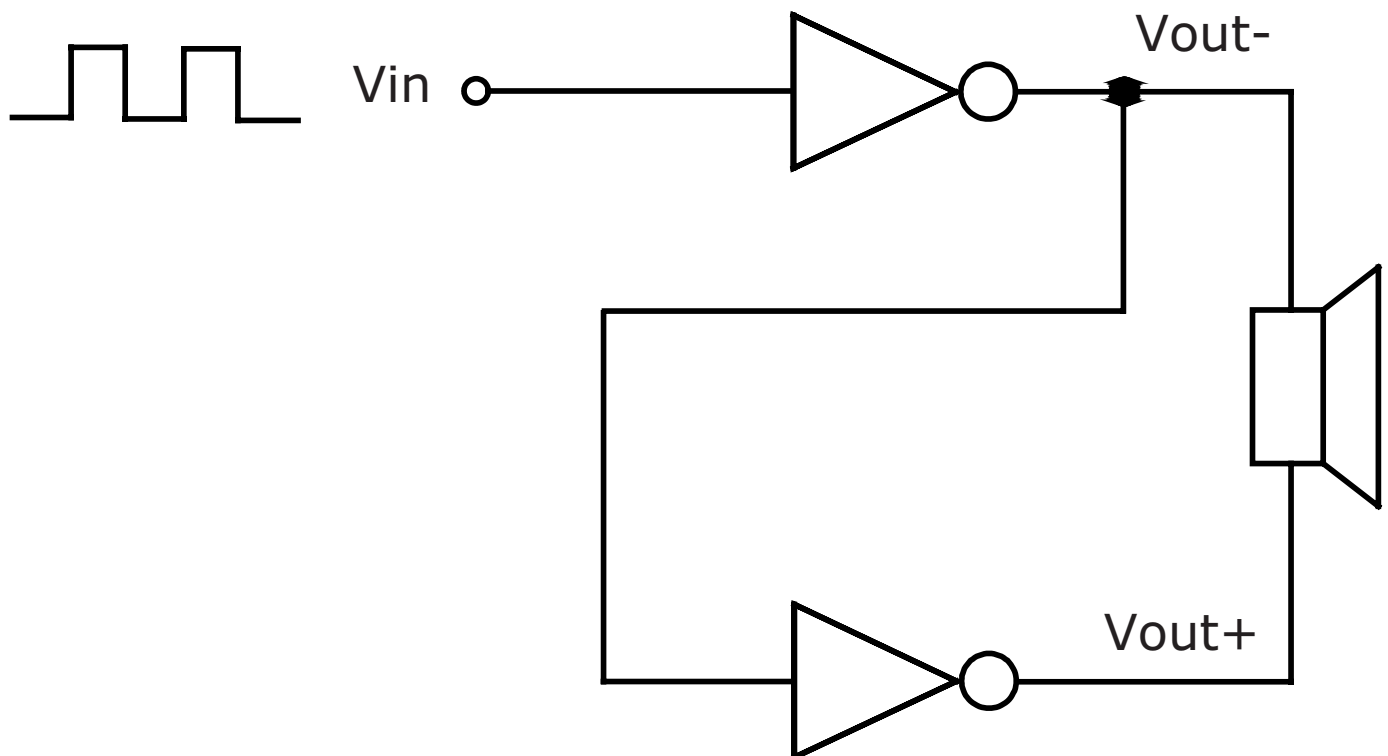

APPLICATION CIRCUIT

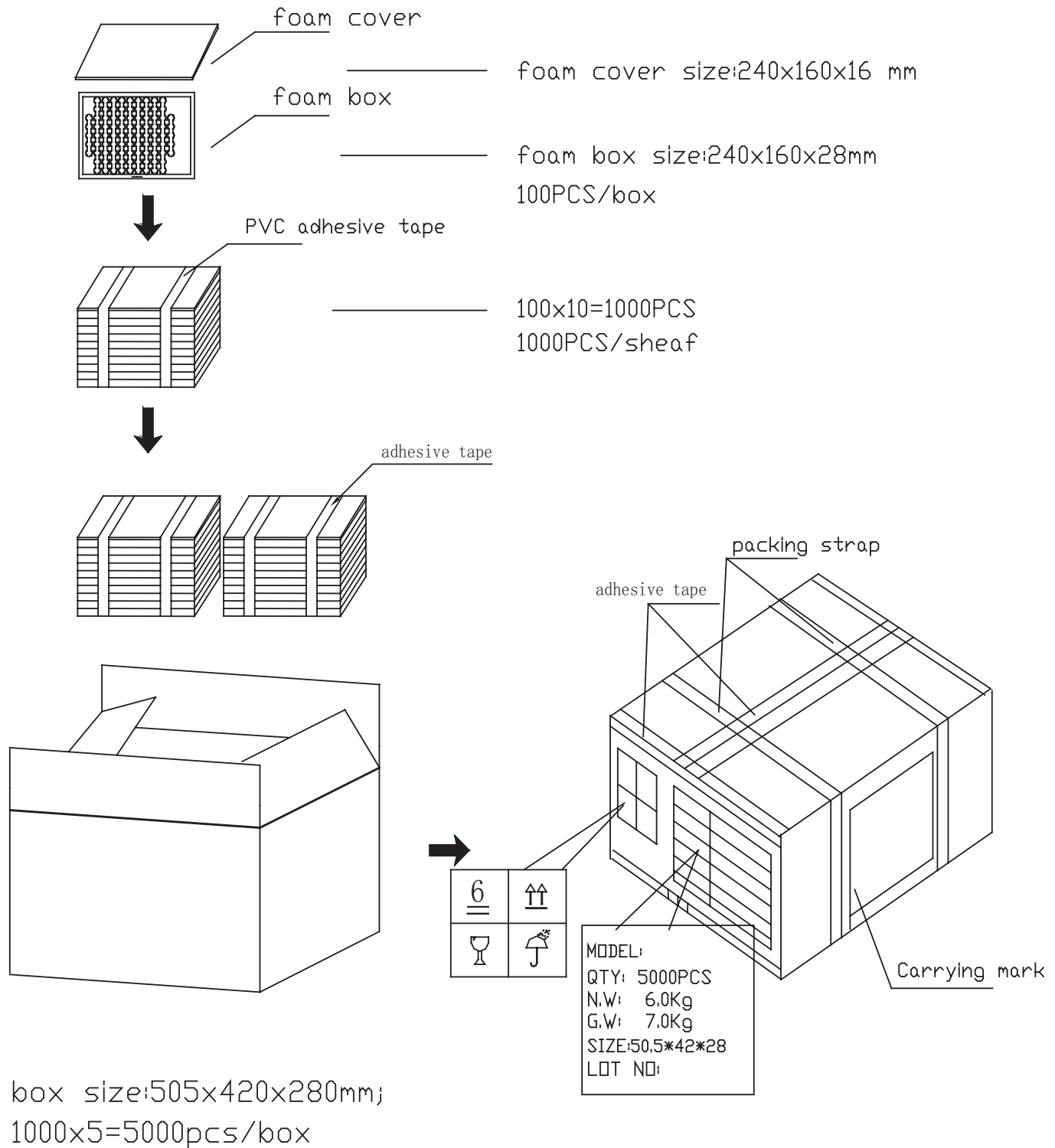
