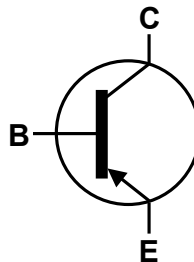

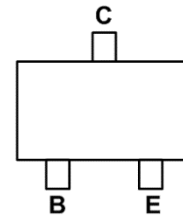

Device Symbol



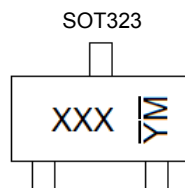
Top View

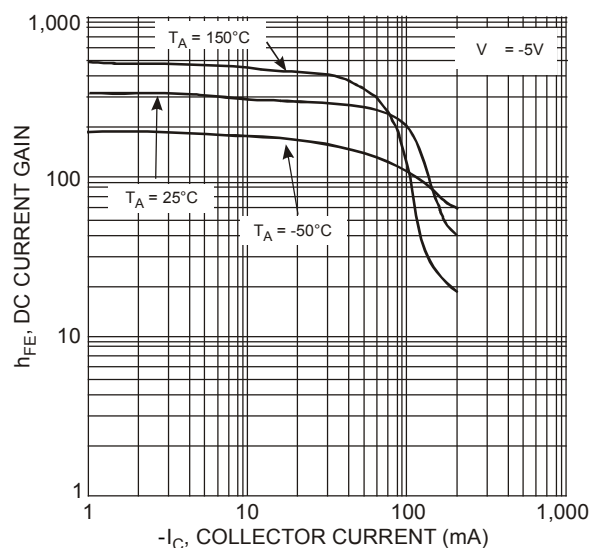

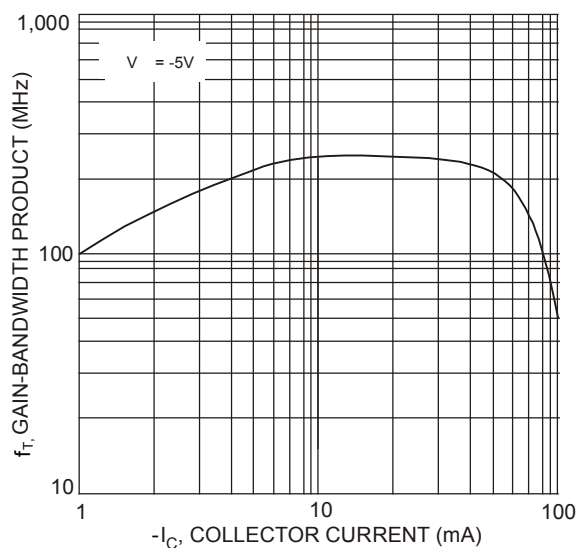
Power Dissipation vs.

$h_{FE} \text{ v } I_C$

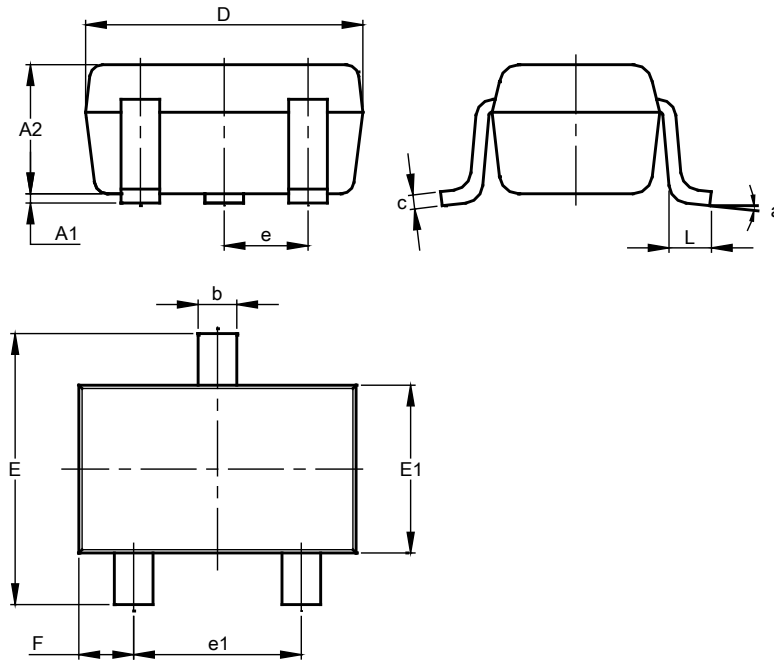


$f_T \text{ v } I_C$

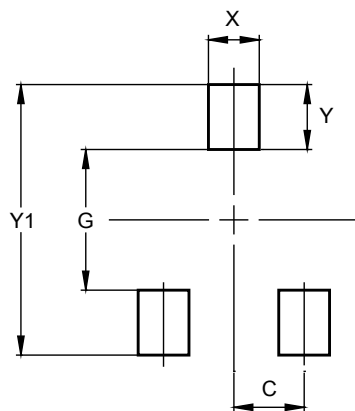
